Time Frame	January 2004
Location	Office
Presenting Issues	Wife feels rejected. No communication in the marriage. Husband's time is taken up with his work. No family time.
Mediatory Approach	Narrative
Process Description	Each session began with an expression of thanks, an appreciation of the third party intervention, purposes for mediation, process for the day and hopeful outcomes. Mediator established communication pattern between the parties by encouraging them to talk directly to each other. Effective communication was established (with minimal help from mediator) between parties as they exchanged dialogue on issues affecting them. Mediator's comment was made in the form of suggestions in helping clients to problem solve and arrive at variable solutions.
Outcome	Clients agreed to better time management, to spend more time with each other and as a family.
